On 22 January 2014, the closing ceremony of a two year long EU funded police assistance twinning project with a budget of 1.2 mn Euros funded from IPA 2008, was held in Sarajevo. The aim of the project was to establish stronger co-operation and co-ordination between all BiH enforcement agencies and strengthening the capacity of the Directorate for the Coordination of Police Bodies of BiH (DPC) in line with EU standards and best practices.

European Parliament election will be held between 22 and 25 May 2014

Elections to the European Parliament will be held in all EU member states between 22 and 25 May 2014, as decided by the Council of the EU. The 2014 elections are being held in late May instead of early June, as had been the case in the past, in order to provide more time for the election of a president of the European Commission.
