IPA II: Over 11 billion euro to support reform efforts in enlargement countries

On September 26, the European Commission unveiled details of how the EU will support reform efforts in the Western Balkans and Turkey for the next 7 years. The funding, agreed by the EU last year, totals €11 billion and will be available through the new Instrument for Pre-accession Assistance (IPA II).
