The assistance will be comprised of two independent components/lots:

Lot 1: Development of an Agricultural Market Information System: aim of this component will be to establish a low cost Agriculture Market Information System (MIS) delivering relevant, accurate and timely information to agriculture market users and policy decision-makers throughout BiH; and

Lot 2. Development of a framework for Land Parcel Identification System (LPIS) in BiH: this component will aim at establishing a framework for LPIS, based on a pilot digital geo-database consisting of ortho-photos, production blocks and thematic layers for the identification of all agricultural parcels in production areas, as a first step towards establishment of the integrated nation-wide LPIS.

Both components of this technical assistance will be complemented by a separate supply tender related to the procurement of software and hardware for IT support to implementation of MIS and LPIS pilot schemes.
