#### 1. Basic act and Financing source

#### 2. Objectives of the programme, priorities for the year 2007 and expected results

The specific objectives of the Call for Proposal in 2007 under the Programme for Bosnia and Herzegovina is the following:

#### 3. Eligibility conditions

Participation in tendering is open to all legal persons heaving their headquarters (except for international organizations and agencies) in the EC Member states, Albania, BiH, Croatia, FYROM. Serbia, Montenegro, Iceland, Norway, Lichtenstein, Turkey.

#### 4. Selection and award criteria

The evaluation will be carried out in accordance with the procedures set out in the Practical Guide to contract procedures for EC external actions

### 5. Maximum rate of Community financing

Financial Assistance will generally consist of a contribution (grant) comprising up to 90% of the total eligible costs of the project.

The minimum and maximum amounts are determined as set out in section 7.

The initially foreseen maximum duration of a projects is 3 years.
