**6. Description of the contract**

To provide BiH courts as well as the High Judicial and Prosecutorial Council with the necessary Information and Communication Technology (ICT).

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## TERMS OF PARTICIPATION

**8. Eligibility and rules of origin**

Participation is open to all legal persons participating either individually or in a grouping (consortium) of tenderers which are established in a Member State of the European Union or in a country or territory of the regions covered and/or authorised by the specific instruments applicable to the programme under which the contract is financed (see item 22 below), ([http://ec.europa.eu/europeaid/work/procedures/implementation/eligibility/index\\_en.htm](http://ec.europa.eu/europeaid/work/procedures/implementation/eligibility/index_en.htm)); next enter **GENERAL ANNEX A2** Eligibility programmes 2007-2013 and go to **Instrument for Pre-Accession Assistance (Council Regulation (EC) N° 1085/2006 - OJ L 210/82 of 31.7.2006)**. All goods supplied under this contract must originate in one or more of

these countries. Participation is also open to international organisations. Participation of natural persons is directly governed by the specific instruments applicable to the programme under which the contract is financed.

## **9. Grounds for exclusion**

Tenderers must submit a signed declaration, included in the Tender Form for a Supply Contract, to the effect that they are not in any of the situations listed in point 2.3.3 of the Practical Guide to contracts procedures for EU external actions.

## **10. Number of tenders**

Tenderers may submit only one tender. Tenders for parts of a lot will not be considered. Any tenderer may state in its tender that it would offer a discount in the event that its tender is accepted. Tenderers may not submit a tender for a variant solution in addition to their tender for the supplies required in the tender dossier.

## **11. Tender guarantee**

Tenderers must provide a tender guarantee in the amount of **6,500 Euro**. This guarantee will be released to unsuccessful tenderers once the tender procedure has been completed and to the successful tenderer(s) upon signature of the contract by all parties. This guarantee will be called upon if the tenderer does not fulfil all obligations stated in its tender.

## **12. Performance guarantee**

The successful tenderer will be asked to provide a performance guarantee of **10 %** of the amount of the contract at the signing of the contract. This guarantee must be provided together with the return of the countersigned contract no later than 30 days after the tenderer receives the contract signed by the Contracting Authority. If the selected tenderer fails to provide such a guarantee within this period, the contract will be void and a new contract may be drawn up and sent to the tenderer which has submitted the next cheapest compliant tender.

## **13. Information meeting and or/site visit**

No information meeting and/or site visit is planned.

## **14. Tender validity**

Tenders must remain valid for a period of 90 days after the deadline for submission of tenders.

## **15. Period of implementation of tasks**

The limit for completion is within 195 days from the commencement date.

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# **SELECTION AND AWARD CRITERIA**

## **16. Selection criteria**

The following selection criteria will be applied to tenderers. In the case of tenders submitted by a consortium, these selection criteria will be applied to the consortium as a whole:

- 1) Economic and financial capacity of tenderer (based on i.a. item 3 of the Tender Form for a Supply Contract). In case of tenderer being a public body, equivalent information should be provided.
  - (a) the average turnover of the tenderer for the last 3 years must exceed the total value of its financial proposal.
- 2) Professional capacity of tenderer (based on i.a. items 4 and 5 of the Tender Form for a Supply Contract)
  - (a) the tenderer has a minimum of 5 staff employed on a permanent basis in field related to this contract.
- 3) Technical capacity of tenderer (based on i.a. items 5 and 6 of the Tender Form for a Supply Contract)
  - (a) Over the past thirty-six (36) months before the submission deadline for this tender procedure, the tenderer has successfully completed at least two (2) contracts in the related fields with a budget per contract of at least the same as the financial proposal offered under this tender.

An economic operator may, where appropriate and for a particular contract, rely on the capacities of other entities, regardless of the legal nature of the links which it has with them. Some examples of when it may *not* be considered appropriate by the Contracting Authority are when the tenderer rely in majority on the capacities of other entities or when they rely on key criteria. If the tenderer rely on other entities it must prove to the Contracting Authority that it will have at its disposal the resources necessary for performance of the contract, for example by producing an undertaking on the part of those entities to place those resources at its disposal. Such entities, for instance the parent company of the economic operator, must respect the same rules of eligibility and notably that of nationality, as the economic operator. Furthermore, the data for this third entity for the relevant selection criterion should be included in the tender in a separate document. Proof of the capacity will also have to be furnished when requested by the Contracting Authority.
