Subject: Request for Derogation

Re: IPA 2010 - Supply of ICT equipment and software for Judicial Institutions in Bosnia and Herzegovina

Through the Instrument for Pre-Accession's 2010 Annual Programme the European Union will continue to support the informatisation of the judiciary of Bosnia and Herzegovina (BiH).

More specifically, the IPA 2010 Judiciary fiche foresees the provision of Information and Communication technology (ICT) equipment and software to further support the case management system in courts and prosecutor offices throughout BiH. Amongst the results of the support will be increased judicial efficiency and accessibility through the scanning and electronic filing of incoming documents in courts and prosecutor offices. The support will include 5 lots for a total value of 1,800,000 eur.

In preparing the technical specifications and associated market research for the ICT support, the IT department of the High Judicial and Prosecutorial Council (HJPC) of BiH noted that the superior quality scanners sought under lot 2 are not produced in countries covered by the Council Regulations (EC) No 1085/2006 (Instrument for Pre-accession Assistance), nor in the Practical Guide Article 2.3.1.

Therefore, a derogation from rule of origin is requested for the following lot :

Lot 2: Scanners:

2.1 - Scanner Type I

2.2 - Scanner Type II

The estimated value of the above listed lot is **95,700.00 EUR**.

Bearing in mind that this derogation requires the approval of the Head of Delegation (HoD), following the review of colleagues from Operations and Contracts and Finance, the draft letter for the HoD's signature is enclosed in the dossier.

Subject: Derogation from the Rule of Origin for IPA 2010 "Supply of ICT equipment for judicial institutions in Bosnia and Herzegovina"

Lot 2: Scanners

2.1 - Scanner Type I

2.2 - Scanner Type II

The value of the above mentioned supplies is approximately **95,700.00 EUR**. The request is based on market analysis performed by the IT Department of the High Judicial and Prosecutorial Council of BiH, which shows that the origin regulated by the Council Regulation (EC) No 1085/2006 (Instrument for Pre-accession Assistance) cannot be guaranteed for the items.

The grounds for derogation is Article 19, paragraph 6 ("Rules of participation and origin") of the above referenced Council Regulation.
