Clarification to the Service Contract Notice

Project Title: Provision of preliminary designs and studies for removing the

railway traffic bottleneck occurring at Ivan-Bradina

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Question 1:

Under point 6 Experience in the application form, it is stated that the project will be considered in its whole if proper evidence of performance is provided (statement or certificate from the entity which awarded the contract...).

Is it a necessary to include such a statements or certificates in the application form for the EoI as a proof for each reference or such evidence have to be submitted only upon additional request of the Contracting Authority?

Answer 1:

Statements, certificates or any other evidence of the experience are not to be submitted at the prequalification stage. Short-listed candidates will be requested to submit documentary evidence of the financial and economic capacity as well as the technical and professional capacity according to the selection criteria specified in the contract notice together with their offer (see further point 2.4.11 of the Practical Guide). However, please pay attention to Selection criterion under 21.2a of the Service Contract Notice stating:

"Possession of license for design of civil engineering structures ('projektiranje objekata niskogradnje'), or specifically railways ('željeznica'), valid under the Law of Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina, shall be considered mandatory for the applicant or at least 1 member of the applicant consortium at the time of application. The copy of the license shall be attached to the application".
